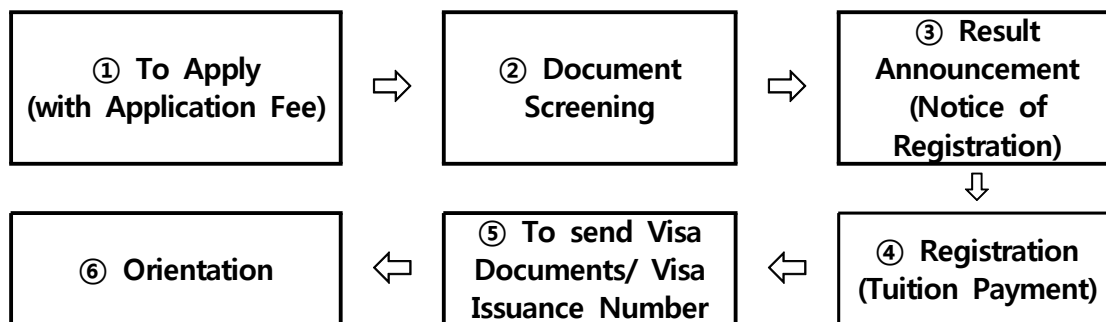

## 1. Eligibility

- 1) Original copy of Bachelor's and Master's Certificate of Graduation, or notarized Certificate of Graduation must be submitted

- 2) Original copy of Bachelor's Degree (and Master's Degree if applicable), or notarized copies must be submitted.
- 3) Original transcript issued by the last attended educational institution
- 4) Two (2) recommendation letters from two (2) professors from the last attended educational institution
- 5) Original Household Register or notarized copy that includes all household members.
- 6) Certificates of Employment of both father and mother; either parent can be the primary sponsor of the applicant (however, students applying from China need to provide Certificates of Employment and Certificates of Income of both parents.)

## **5. Application Fee**

- 1) Application Fee: 100,000 KRW or 100 USD
- 2) International Transfer to designated Daegu Bank Account or direct payment at International Services Office
- 3) Please note that application will not be processed without application fee.

## **6. Additional Information for Application**

- 1) All the required documents must be translated into Korean or English.
- 2) The academic supervisor must provide International Services with the authorization to collect the Certificate of Employment and Certificate of Income from the responsible departments when guarantees financial support for a student.

Necessary documents are as follows:

- Original copy of bank statement indicating sponsor's account balance over \$10,000 USD
  - Certificate of Employment of the sponsor (International Services to collect)
  - Certificate of Income of the sponsor (International Services to collect)
- 3) Chinese applicants who need to get an entry visa to Korea should submit the following documents even though an academic supervisor guarantees financial support

- Certificates of Employment for both father and mother, respectively (if any)
- Certificates of Income for both father and mother, respectively (if any)
- Original copy of bank statements for either father or mother

- 4) When additional documents are needed, applicants will be informed individually
- 5) Official report of English or Korean Proficiency test taken by May 11th 2010 (such as TOEFL, TOEIC, TEPS, IELTS, KLPT, KLAT or TOPIK) should be included in the application package, if applicable.
- 6) Applicant should select the exact major and department that they are applying for. Any disadvantage caused by applicant's mistake is her/his responsibility and application documents and fees will not be refunded.

Chinese	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Apply for "Visa Issuance Certificate Number" at the Korean Immigration Office in Daegu</li> <li>- Yeungnam University International Services to receive "Visa Issuance Certificate Number" from the Korean Immigration Office in Daegu</li> <li>- Deliver Visa Number to applicants by e-mail</li> <li>- Applicants to apply for "Entry Visa" with the Visa Issuance Certificate Number and the required documents at the Korean Embassy or at a Korean Consulate in China → Obtain "Entry Visa" (D-2), and enter Korea</li> </ul>
Others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Yeungnam University to mail admission materials, including "Certificate of Admission," to applicants in order to apply for "Entry Visa"</li> <li>- Applicants to apply for "Entry Visa" with the required documents at the Korean Embassy at a Korean Consulate in the applicant's country → Obtain "Entry Visa" (D-2), and enter Korea</li> </ul>
